Title	Does the title adhere to the recommendations of the Guide for Authors?  □ Yes □ No	The title must be concise and informative. Avoid abbreviations, acronyms or formulae. Discussions should contain the title of the paper under discussion. Only the first letter of the first word should be capitalized.
Authors' names and affiliations	Do the formats of the authors' names and affiliations adhere to the Guide for Authors?  □ Yes □ No	The first name(s) should not be abbreviated. The authors are allowed to abbreviate middle name(s). Affiliation(s) should follow the format: Institution, (Department), City, (State), Country.
