Word count	Main text: Single-column figures: Double-column figures: Single-column tables: Double-column tables:	The main text word count limits exclude the title page, notation list (e.g., symbols, abbreviations), captions of tables and figures, acknowledgments and references.
	Total word count:	The total word count is the sum of all aforementioned counts and it should be lower than the maximum count allowable for each category. See the Guide for Authors for the maximum and equivalent word counts.

Cover letter	Does the cover letter adhere to the Guide for Authors?  Yes No	The cover letter should include: manuscript title, submission type, authorship information, statement of key findings and work novelty, and related previous publications if applicable.
Title	Does the title adhere to the recommendations of the Guide for Authors?  ☐ Yes ☐ No	The title must be concise and informative. Avoid abbreviations, acronyms or formulae. Discussions should contain the title of the paper under discussion. Only the first letter of the first word should be capitalized.
Authors' names and affiliations	Do the formats of the authors' names and affiliations adhere to the Guide for Authors?  Yes No	The first name(s) should not be abbreviated. The authors are allowed to abbreviate middle name(s). Affiliation(s) should follow the format: Institution, (Department), City, (State), Country.



Corresponding author	Has the corresponding author been indicated?  ☐ Yes ☐ No	The corresponding author should be identified by a pound sign # beside his/her and in a footnote.
English expression quality	Have grammar and technical writing been revised?  ☐ Yes ☐ No	Authors must proof read and revise all aspects pertaining to the quality of English expression. That is not a role of the editorial, review or publishing teams.
Declaration of interest	Was the declaration of interest included in the manuscript?  ☐ Yes ☐ No	A section entitled "Declaration of interest" should be included following any acknowledgments and prior to the reference section. In case of the absence of conflicting interests, the authors should still include a declaration of interest.
Authorship statements	Were the authorship statements included in the manuscript?  ☐ Yes ☐ No	A section entitled "Authorship statements" should be included following the declaration of interest section. Please refer to the Guide for Authors for formatting matters and acceptance criteria for authorship.
